

Keep track of your songs!

NCB has developed a new web service – **Album & Track Search** – that helps you to keep track of all your songs that have been released throughout the years.

All songs that have been licensed by NCB for release on audio and audio-visual recordings are registered in this database – on album as well as on track level.

It includes songs that have been released on physical media as well as electronically.

The service has been designed to be easy-to-use and to provide extensive search capabilities.

You can search not only on your own songs but any song released in the Nordic/Baltic countries and licensed by NCB.

Features

There are two main search levels:

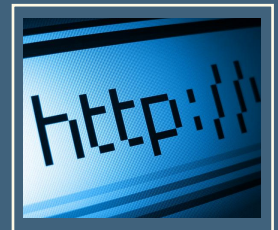
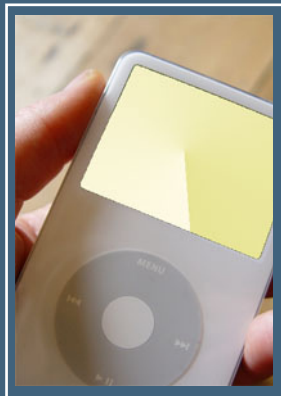
Album level – Here you can search on album titles, album artists, catalogue numbers and even a combination of album title and artist. When you perform a search, each result shown will be linked to track details and information on the record company that released the album.

Track level – Here you can search on track titles, track artists and a combination of song title and artist. The results will be linked to detailed track information on rights owners. On track level you can also look up information on your own – and only your own – shares in a specific song and information on all the albums that contain this song.

Free service to all members

This service is available to all composers, songwriters and music publishers that are members of any of the Nordic and Baltic music performing rights societies (AKKA/LAA, EAÜ, KODA, LATGA-A, TEOSTO, TONO, STEF, STIM) – and to direct NCB members as well.

The service is open 24/7 - and best of all it's free!
