

Look up information on your distribution data

NCB has developed a new web service:
Distribution Search.

This service enables you to look up information on NCB royalties that you have received since December 2005 and up till now.

The service has been designed to be easy-to-use and to provide comprehensive search facilities which can be used separately or in combinations.

As a registered users you can search your own data only. When you have performed a search on a specific song your results can e.g. be shown as total royalties generated from various albums on which the song has been released.

Such totals can cover a specific distribution period or several periods. Your search results can be limited to a specific type of collection or country of sale.

Features

Distribution Search provides you with the following search options:

- Work titles – songs for which the member has received NCB royalties
- Artist – artists performing the songs
- Recordings – albums on which your songs have been released
- Producers – producers who have released albums that generated NCB royalties to the member

Music publishers also have the following search options:

- Agreements – original publishing and sub-publishing agreements covering the songs they control
- Administrators – agreements with composers and administrators

The service is integrated with “Album & Track Search” that was launched in September 2007. This means that you need only one click to look up album details on releases and tracks. You can also select details on rights owners and your own shares in the song.

Free service to all members

This service is available to all composers, songwriters and music publishers that are members of any of the Nordic and Baltic music performing rights societies (AKKA/LAA, EAÜ, KODA, LATGA-A, TEOSTO, TONO, STEF, STIM) – and to direct NCB members as well. The service is open 24/7 - and best of all it's free!
