At present 30 pct. of all signatories to NCB's audio standard contract are using NCB's web application WebCover for registration of new releases.

WebCover offers you swift and easy registration of you releases and gives you access to one of the world's largest music data bases. This also gives you a splendid overview of your – and others' – back

catalogue, including recordings that were released years ago.

To access WebCover you will need a personal password which you can obtain from NCB – provided that you in future register all your releases in the WebCover application.

New year, new name & new tasks

NCB's "Audio Standard Licensing Services" changed its name to "Standard Agreements" as at 1 January 2007.

So far the department has been in charge of the administration of audio-only standard agreements.

The reason for changing the name is that the department now also administers all standard agreements covering audio and audio-visual products.

This means that standard agreements covering CD-ROM, Karaoke, light entertainment programmes and feature films will be handled by our department for Standard Agreements.

Those of you who have so far dealt with our AV Department will now be serviced by other NCB contact persons. In the near future we expect to update certain administrative procedures, including release registration and sales reporting, but we shall get back to that in due time.
